Regional Center of Excellence for Nutrition Rehabilitation Resource and Training has been established at AIIMS Bhopal to provide technical support to the efforts of State Government to combat severe acute malnutrition among children U5. Department of Community and Family Medicine (CFM) is supporting National Health Mission (NHM) and DWCD in this regard as the State Center of Excellence(SCoE) in capacity building, knowledge management, technical and operational support to program implementation, monitoring and feedback. Applications of eligible candidates are invited to for the following posts on purely contractual basis for the CSAM & AMB Project.

Purpose of the posts: Under the technical guidance of Dept of Community and Family Medicine (AIIMS Bhopal) and in collaboration with DWCD and NHM, provide technical and operational support to plan, implement and monitor Community based management of Sever Acute Malnutrition (CSAM) and Anemia Mukt Bharat programme (AMB). AIIMS Bhopal as SCoE is also collaborating with NCoE for CSAM in research and allied activities. Technical oversight and funding for the position shall be provided by a respected, International Development Agency that works across the globe, to promote children's survival, protection and development. The advertised posts are for the conduct of field activities with regard to CSAM programme.

Sr.No 1: Field Investigator (No of posts: 2)

Field investigator will be responsible for the overall study related field activities. This will include identification and conducting anthropometric and body composition assessments of children with severe acute malnutrition (SAM) at different time points, conducting interviews with caregivers, coordinating with frontline health and nutrition workers for keeping records of enrolled children, ensuring quality of data collection and other additional work assigned by Principal Investigator/ Co-PI of the study from the state.

Major Duties and Responsibilities (including but not limited to):

- Identification of children with SAM by anthropometric assessment using WHZ <-3 criteria
- Enrolment of the child in this study based on inclusion/exclusion criteria

- To take informed consent from the parents for the sub-sample of children who will be assessed for body composition
- Data collection of the child including details of the child and incidences of morbidity using a questionnaire, and measurement for weight, height/Length, skinfold thickness (triceps and subscapular) and BIA (only in sub-sample) at the time of baseline and exit
- Administration of questionnaire for consumption of locally produced energy dense food with all enrolled children at 6 weeks, 12 weeks and 16 weeks/exit
- Monthly follow up of discharged children for anthropometry (height & weight)
- Co-ordinate with the local staff including ANM and AWW for enrollment and followup of children
- Make sure that all the instruments being used in the study are regularly tested for accuracy
- Data entry in the mobile phone based app
- Ensure quality of data collection
- Ensure safe keeping of the instruments
- Report issues/concerns/errors to the SCoE and NCoE
- Any other role assigned by the SCoE and NCoE related to the study.

Sr. No.2: Field Investigators (Short Term Assignment-30 days) No. of Posts - 10

A concurrent monitoring and anthropometry validation exercise has to be done under CSAM project in Babai Block of Hoshangabad District. For this purpose, 10 Field investigators will be engaged on Short Term Contract of 30 days as per details mentioned below

Major duties and responsibilities (including but not limited to):

- Each Field Investigator will be trained and assigned to team of 2 Field Investigators
- Each team will conduct survey of around 600 households within 30 days i.e. 20-25 Households per day and 5 teams will cover 3000 Households within 30 days
- Conduct House to House Survey in villages of Babai Block
- Perform anthropometry (Weight, Height measurement) of Children Under-5 years of Age
- Submit daily report to Programme Coordinator (CSAM) and Field Monitor (CSAM)
- Maintain records and registers during survey period

Age relaxation is admissible in respect of SC/ST/OBC candidates, Retrenched Government Employees, Departmental Candidates (including projects), and exservicemen in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Government from time to time. Age concession to the extent of services rendered in the research projects will also be admissible for experienced and skilled persons.

The final selection of the candidate will be based on the marks scored in the written exam, educational qualification and relevant experience with a weightage of 3:1:1
