Essential Qualification: (a) A recognized medical Qualification included in the I or II schedule or Part II of the third schedule (other than the Licentiate Qualifications) to the Indian Medical Council Act of 1956. Holders of educational qualifications included in Part II of third schedule should also fulfill the conditions specified in sub-section (3) of section 13 of IMC the Act) - 1956

(b) Double Post Graduate i.e. MD/MS along with M.Ch. (Thoracic Surgery)/M.Ch. (Cardio Thoracic Surgery) or Specialty board of Thoracic Surgery (USA) OR equivalent.

(c) **In case a M.Ch. (CTS) candidate is not available, M.S.(Surgery) with experience in Thoracic Surgery will also be considered.**

Experience: Two years working experience after obtaining the first Post Degree of MS/MD.

Note-I: The Medical Qualifications possessed by the candidates should have the recognition of the Medical Council of India.

Note-II: Holders of specialty board of USA qualifications should complete the entire requirements of the Board concerned.

Note-III: In so far as post graduate medical qualifications awarded by Indian Universities are concerned, they should also find a place in the Schedules to the Indian Medical council Act, 1956, as amended from time to time.

Note-IV: In the case of holder of DM. /M.Ch. qualification of five years duration, the period of senior post graduate residency rendered in the last part of the said DM/M.Ch shall be counted towards requirement of five years experience.

Note-V: In the case of qualification in Super-Specialties (M.Ch/DM) except in the case of holders of DM/M.Ch. of five years duration, the holders should have obtained MD (General Medicine) or MS (General Surgery) or an equivalent qualification as prescribed by the said council in its recommendations on post graduate medical examination.

Age: Upto 45 years.

Conditions of Recruitment:

1. **Eligible candidate will present themselves for registration at 02.00 PM in Administrative block** on the day specified for the interview of a particular specialty alongwith the application duly filled in the prescribed format as per annexure-I with all relevant document in original together with attested copies (by Gazetted Officer) in the support of their candidature for the post. **No application of candidate will be received after 02.30 PM. Interview will start from 03.00 PM onwards.**
2. Crucial date of determination of eligibility with regards to age, educational qualification etc. will be the date of registration of the candidates appearing in the interview.
3. ***Candidates must be registered with Delhi Medical Council before joining the post, if selected.***
4. Other service conditions will be applicable as prescribed by the Govt. of India from time to time.
5. The candidate who is already in Govt. Service should submit NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE from the employer at the time of interview.
6. Candidate must bring the following original certificates with self-attested copies at the time of interview:
 - Certificate in support of age/DoB (10th Certificate).
 - Certificate in support of educational qualifications.
 - Experience certificate, if any.
 - Medical registration certificates of DMC.

 - Physically Handicapped Certificate from Competent Authority, where applicable.
 - The candidate must bring the filled application from as per format given and also paste recent passport size photograph on it.
